The Court orders that all four motions to remand pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(1) are DENIED. Defendant-appellant's request for an evidentiary hearing based on the nondisclosure of exculpatory evidence has not been properly supported to show that the record should be further developed regarding the prosecution's suppression of material evidence. Defendant-appellant's request for an evidentiary hearing based on an eyewitness's identification is not necessary when the trial court appears to have granted that request, but limited the scope of the hearing, and defendant-appellant has not shown that the trial court's reasons for not expanding the scope of the hearing were erroneous. Defendant-appellant's request for an evidentiary hearing based on the knowing presentation of perjured testimony does not appear to involve any new information that was not previously made a part of the record or brought to the trial court's attention. Defendant-appellant has also not properly shown that an evidentiary hearing is necessary because his trial attorney decided not to call all possible alibi witnesses.
