The Court orders that the motion to determine the Court's jurisdiction is GRANTED and the claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. The Court lacks jurisdiction of the claim of appeal filed by the trial court pursuant to MCR 6.425(G) because the conviction and sentence pursuant to defendant-appellant's plea of *nolo contendere* is not appealable by right, MCR 7.203(A)(1)(b), and the order denying defendant-appellant's motion for writ of mandamus is not a final order in a criminal case that is appealable by right. MCR 7.203(A)(1); MCR 7.202(6)(b). Even if the order denying the request for a writ of mandamus were considered to conclude a separate civil action, the claim of appeal is neither timely filed nor properly filed by order of the trial court pursuant to MCR 6.425(G).
