The Court orders that the application for leave to appeal is DENIED because defendant has failed to meet the burden of establishing entitlement to relief under MCR 6.508(D). Defendant alleges grounds for relief that could have been raised previously and has failed to establish both good cause for failing to previously raise the issues and actual prejudice from the irregularities alleged. Defendant has not established that good cause should be waived. MCR 6.508(D)(3)(a) and (b).

The motion to remand is DENIED.

Gleicher, J., would grant defendant's application for leave to appeal regarding whether the prosecutor committed misconduct by failing to disclose information regarding the complainant that may have been required pursuant to Brady v Maryland, 373 US 83 (1963), and as to whether both trial and appellate counsel were constitutionally ineffective for the reasons stated in defendant's application papers. Gleicher, J., would also grant defendant's motion for remand.
