The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The Court further orders, pursuant to MCR 7.206(D)(4), that this matter is to proceed to a full hearing at a special session of this Court based on the parties' existing pleadings.

The Court invites the Michigan Association of Justice and the Michigan Defense Trial Counsel to file briefs amicus curiae. Other persons or groups interested in the determination of the questions presented in this case may move the Court for permission to file briefs amicus curiae. Amicus curiae briefs shall be filed by June 16, 2014.

The motion for oral argument is GRANTED. Oral Argument will occur before this Court at its courtroom on the 14th floor of Cadillac Place, located at 3020 West Grand Boulevard, Detroit, Michigan, at 9:00 A.M. on July 8, 2014. The time allowed for argument shall be 30 minutes for each side. An amicus curiae cannot participate in oral argument except by order of the Court.

The motion for stay is DISMISSED as MCL 600.308(4) limits this Court's jurisdiction in this original action to actions challenging the validity of sections 6404, 6410, 6413, or 6419, and such jurisdiction does not extend over *Okrie v Michigan*. Court of Claims Docket No. 13-93-MK. Plaintiff may file a delayed application for leave to appeal the Court of Claims order denying the stay. MCR 7.203(B)(1), MCR 7.205(G).
