The Court orders that the complaint for superintending control is **DISMISSED IN PART**, limited to plaintiff's claims against the Thirty-Seventh District Court Judge. Complaints for superintending control against district judges are not appropriately filed in this Court. See *People v Yeotis*, 383 Mich 429, 432; 175 NW2d 750 (1970); MCR 3.301(A); MCR 7.203(C)(1).

The Court further orders that plaintiff's claims against the Macomb County Circuit Court Judge in the complaint for superintending control, which we treat as a delayed application for leave to appeal, are **DENIED** for lack of merit in the grounds presented.

The motion for summary disposition is **DENIED** as moot.
