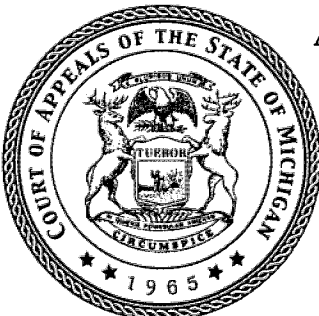

By order entered on July 10, 2014, the Court granted Court Reporter Janice I. Payne's motion to extend the time to file the transcript 88 days until August 25, 2014, but directed the Clerk to submit the matter for disciplinary action pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f) if the transcript was not filed by August 25, 2014. On August 25, 2014, Ms. Payne filed a motion to extend the time to file the transcript an additional 32 days until September 26, 2014.

The Court orders that the motion to extend the time to file the transcripts an additional 32 days is DENIED. In lieu of ordering the court reporter to show cause, the Court, pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), orders that Court Reporter Janice I. Payne (R 3521) is ASSESSED costs in the amount of \$250 as a sanction for her failure to file the transcript within the extended period allowed. The costs shall be paid to the Clerk of this Court within 21 days after the date this order is entered.

If the complete transcript is not filed by October 15, 2014, the Clerk is directed to submit the matter for further disciplinary action pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), which could include the assessment of additional costs and an order barring the court reporter from recording further proceedings until all of the reporter's overdue transcripts ordered for purposes of appeal are filed with the trial court clerk.
