David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not timely filed in relation to the judgment of sentence entered on January 10, 1996, and the February 6, 2014, order denying relief from judgment is not a final order that is appealable by right. MCR 7.203(A), MCR 7.202(6)(b), and MCR 7.204(A). An appeal from an order denying a motion for relief from judgment under MCR 6.500 *et seq.* must come by application for leave to appeal filed pursuant to MCR 7.205. MCR 6.509(A).

Defendant's prison account statement is treated as a motion to waive fees and the motion is GRANTED for this case only.
