E. Thomas Fitzgerald, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to consolidate is GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that these appeals are CONSOLIDATED to advance the efficient administration of the appellate process. Further, the Clerk's Office of this Court is directed to review further appeals filed as to this Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) case, Docket No. U-11756, for possible submission for administrative consolidation with these appeals.

The motion to hold these appeals in abeyance is GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that these appeals are held in abeyance until the MPSC enters an order that either alone or in combination with prior MPSC orders concludes the currently ongoing proceedings in this MPSC case. As the moving party, Michigan Bell Telephone Company is directed to notify the Clerk's Office of this Court in writing within 14 days after entry of the MPSC order concluding the currently ongoing proceedings in this MPSC case. The appellant's or appellants' brief in each of these appeals shall be due 56 days after entry of the MPSC order concluding the currently ongoing proceedings in this MPSC case. If further appeals are filed as to this MPSC case, any party may file an appropriate motion for a revised consolidated briefing schedule.
