Joel P. Hoekstra, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

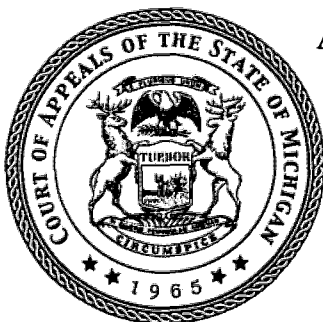
The motions to compel production of records are DENIED AS MOOT for the reason that the circuit court clerk has mailed to appellant the entire contents of the file. Appellant may file a written request with the county probation department for the Presentence Investigation Report and she may request any evidence from the police department.

The motions to compel production of transcripts are DENIED AS MOOT because all transcripts have been filed and mailed to the appellant.

The motion to compel production of exhibits is GRANTED. Within 14 days from the date of this order, the circuit court clerk shall forward the original exhibits to this Court and mail a copy to the appellant.

The motion to extend time to file the appellant's brief is GRANTED until March 16, 2015.
