The Court orders that the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED because defendant has failed to meet the burden of establishing entitlement to relief under MCR 6.508(D). The defendant alleges grounds for relief that could have been raised previously and has failed to establish both good cause for failing to previously raise the issues and actual prejudice from the irregularities alleged, and has not established that good cause should be waived. MCR 6.508(D)(3)(a) and (b). Defendant has also failed to establish that a new trial is warranted on the basis of newly discovered evidence. See *People v Cress*, 468 Mich 678, 692; 664 NW2d 174 (2003).
