The Court orders that the motion to waive the fees is GRANTED and fees are WAIVED for this case only.

The Court orders that the delayed application for leave to appeal is GRANTED, limited to the issues raised in the application. MCR 7.205(E)(4). The time for taking further steps in this appeal runs from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. MCR 7.205(E)(3). Because the prosecutor failed to file an answer to the application for leave to appeal, the Court orders that the prosecutor must file an appellee's brief in reply to appellant's brief, either within 56 days of the Clerk's certification of this order as directed in MCR 6.509(D), or within the time stated in MCR 7.212(A)(2)(a), whichever is later.

Further, on the Court's own motion, this case is REMANDED to the Berrien Circuit Court to forthwith appoint appellate counsel for defendant. Within 14 days after entry of the order of appointment, appointed counsel shall file a copy of the order of appointment with the Clerk's Office of this Court. This Court retains jurisdiction.
