David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not timely filed within 21 days after entry of the July 14, 2014 order appealed from. MCR 7.204(A)(1)(a). Notably, while the claim of appeal refers to the order appealed from as being entered on July 15, 2014, it was actually entered on July 14, 2014. Thus, the filing of the claim of appeal on August 5, 2014, which was 22 days after July 14, 2014, was untimely. At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the July 14, 2014 order by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).

Appellant's affidavit of indigency is treated as a motion to waive fees, and the motion is GRANTED for this case only.
