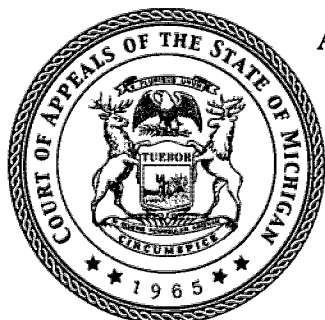

In lieu of granting the application for leave to appeal, defendant's sentence is vacated and the case is remanded to the trial court for resentencing. In the event the trial court imposes a sentence in excess of the applicable guidelines range, the court shall state reasons both for the departure and for the *extent* of the departure. *People v Smith*, 482 Mich 292; 754 NW2d (2008).
