David H. Sawyer, Chief Judge Pro Tem, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not timely filed within 42 days after entry of the June 30, 2014 judgment of sentence. MCR 7.204(A)(2)(c). Further, the claim of appeal cannot be deemed timely under MCR 6.425(G)(3) and MCR 7.204(A)(2)(b) because defendant-appellant did not file a request for appointed appellate counsel with the trial court within that 42-day period. At this time, defendant-appellant may seek to appeal the June 30, 2014 judgment of sentence by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
