William B. Murphy, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the October 14, 2014 order, which was entered by a district court, is not an order that is appealable of right to this Court. MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a). Appellant must appeal the order in question to the proper circuit court. See MCR 7.101(A)(1). Further, defendant cannot claim an appeal in this Court from the Wayne Circuit Court order dated February 18, 2014, because more than 21 days have passed since the entry of the order denying reconsideration of that order. Additionally, defendant previously filed an appeal of the February 18, 2014, order and that application for leave to appeal was denied on its merits (see *US Bank NA v Tony D Partin*, Docket No. 321448, unpublished order of the Michigan Court of Appeals entered August 26, 2014).
