Donald S. Owens, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

In accordance with the Supreme Court's order issued April 29, 2015, this cause is REMANDED to the Alger Circuit Court for a determination of defendant's indigency within 14 days of the Clerk's certification of this order.

If defendant's indigency is established, the Alger Circuit Court shall immediately appoint appellate counsel to represent defendant in this matter, which is on remand from the Supreme Court "for consideration as on leave granted." Matters pertaining to the appointment of an attorney are decided in the trial court. MCR 7.208(G). A copy of an order of appointment, if entered by the Alger Circuit Court, shall be promptly sent to the Court of Appeals.
