The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The motion to extend time to complete remand is also GRANTED. The time for completing the remand proceedings directed by this Court's April 24, 2015 order is extended until September 30, 2015. Further, in the interests of justice, the relevant motion for new trial filed in the trial court shall be treated as if it had been timely filed within the 14-day period for initiating the remand proceedings provided by the April 24, 2015 order.

Further, the motion to add issue on remand is also GRANTED. The remand proceedings ordered by this Court shall be expanded to allow defendant to raise claims for relief and to create an evidentiary record with regard to his indication that documentary evidence reflects that the firearms underlying his felon in possession of a firearm conviction had been transferred from him to his mother.
