This Court's opinion and order entered December 30, 2014, vacated the trial court's order denying defendant's motion to enforce a plea agreement and remanded to the trial court for an evidentiary hearing. This Court retained jurisdiction to further consider the issues on appeal with the record to be developed on remand. On remand, the parties advised the trial court that no evidentiary hearing was necessary, the parties having entered into a plea agreement. Rather than proceed with the evidentiary hearing, the trial court accepted defendant's plea. The matter being resolved through acceptance of defendant's plea, the remaining issues on appeal have been rendered moot. Therefore, on the Court's own motion, this appeal is DISMISSED. MCR 7.211(C)(2); MCR 7.216(A)(7). This Court does not retain jurisdiction.
