The Court orders on its own motion that this matter is REMANDED to settle the record. Specifically, the parties have been unable to provide a legible copy of people's trial exhibit 3 for this Court's review. Before appellate review may continue, the content of the first screen shot contained within the exhibit must be settled. The parties should also address the origin of the photo within the exhibit, what exactly it depicted, and whether it constituted a "mug shot" as alleged during oral argument in this Court.

Within 14 days after the Clerk's certification of this order, defendant-appellant shall initiate the proceeding on remand by filing a motion to settle the record accompanied by a proposed statement of facts. This Court retains jurisdiction.

Defendant-appellant shall file with the Clerk of this Court a copy of the motion to settle the record and copies of all orders entered on remand.

The trial court shall hear and decide the matter within 35 days after the Clerk's certification of this order.

Defendant-appellant shall cause a transcript of any hearing on remand to be prepared and filed within 21 days after completion of the proceedings and any written opinion or order must be filed immediately.
