Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2) and MCR 7.217, orders:

By order entered on January 28, 2015, the Court struck appellant's brief for failure to include a table of contents and a statement of facts as required under MCR 7.212(C)(2) and MCR 7.212(C)(6). The order further directed that the matter be submitted on the involuntary dismissal docket if a conforming appellant's brief was not filed within 14 days. On February 19, 2015, 22 days after the entry of the January 28, 2015, order, appellant filed an amended appellant's brief that still does not include a statement of facts as required under MCR 7.212(C)(6). Accordingly, the amended appellant's brief that was filed on February 19, 2015, is STRICKEN for failure to conform to the requirements of MCR 7.212(C) and the appeal is DISMISSED for want of prosecution, appellant having failed to timely file a brief on appeal that conforms to the requirements of MCR 7.212(C).
