
The Court orders that appellee's motion to remand is DENIED because it is procedurally improper since only an appellant may file a motion to remand. MCR 7.211(C)(1)(a). Further, if the parties wish to conclude this appeal in light of a settlement agreement, they may file a stipulation to dismiss this appeal in this Court under MCR 7.218(B) and an appropriate motion in the Tax Tribunal asking it to enter the contemplated consent judgment. In this regard, pursuant to MCR 7.208(A)(2), the pendency of this appeal would not preclude the Tax Tribunal from setting aside or amending the judgment appealed from by stipulation of the parties.
