The Court issued an opinion and order on February 25, 2015, in which we affirmed the trial court's termination of appellant mother's parental rights to the minor children, affirmed the finding of a statutory ground as to appellant father, but vacated the trial court's best interests findings as to appellant father. *In re Ware, Minors*, unpublished opinion per curiam of the Court of Appeals, issued February 26, 2015 (Dkt. No. 322566 and 322566). On remand the trial court held an evidentiary hearing, took new evidence and heard all the arguments of the parties, and concluded that termination of appellant father's parental rights was in the children's best interests.

After review of the trial court's findings under the appropriate standard of review, we hold that the trial court did not err in its determination that a preponderance of the evidence supported a finding that termination of appellant father's parental rights was in the children's best interests. We therefore AFFIRM the trial court's order after remand.
