The Court orders that the delayed application for leave to appeal the August 26, 2014 order entered by the Wayne County Circuit Court is DENIED because defendant has failed to meet the burden of establishing entitlement to relief under MCR 6.508(D). Although the circuit court denied defendant's motion to correct an invalid sentence on the merits, the trial court should have treated the motion as a motion for relief from judgment. See MCR 6.508(D). The defendant alleges grounds for relief that could have been raised previously and has failed to establish both good cause for failing to previously raise the issues and actual prejudice from the irregularities alleged, and has not established that good cause should be waived. MCR 6.508(D)(3)(a) and (b).
