On the Court's own motion, the original complaint for superintending control is DISMISSED because plaintiff, a prisoner under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, filed the original complaint even though he owes an outstanding balance to this Court in *Davie Lee Jones Jr v People of MI*, Docket No. 320299. A prisoner who is under the Department's jurisdiction cannot file another civil appeal or original action until the prisoner pays the outstanding balance owed in an earlier civil appeal or original action filed while under the Department's jurisdiction. MCL 600.2963(8).
