The complaint for superintending control is DENIED.

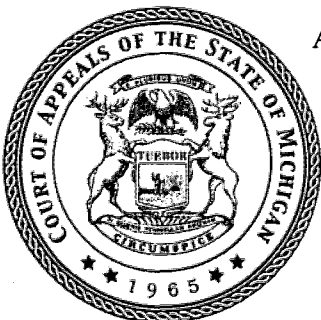
The motion to stay criminal contempt proceedings is DENIED.

The motion for an emergency hearing on the motion to stay criminal contempt proceedings is DENIED.

The motion to waive the requirements of MCR 7.209(A)(3) is GRANTED.

Jansen, J., concurs in part and dissents in part and states as follows: I would treat plaintiff's complaint for superintending control as a delayed application for leave to appeal and grant it. I would also grant plaintiff's motion to stay the criminal contempt proceedings. In all other respects, I concur with the majority.
