Pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), in lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, the Court REMANDS this matter to the Kent circuit court for the ministerial tasks of correcting the presentencing report to conform to the court's rulings on pages 9, 12-13 and 16 of the sentencing transcript and of transmitting a copy of the corrected report to the Department of Corrections. Additionally, the court shall determine whether the sentencing information reports were to be scored identically, and if it is determined that the SIRs were to be scored identically, then the trial court shall enter a corrected SIR for the using a computer to commit a crime conviction to be transmitted to the MDOC with the corrected PSIR. In all other regards, the Court orders that the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED because defendant has failed to meet the burden of establishing entitlement to relief under MCR 6.508(D). This order has immediate effect. The Court does not retain jurisdiction.

Shapiro, J. would GRANT the application for leave to appeal.
