Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

On the Court's own motion, the delayed application for leave to appeal is DISMISSED because appellant, a prisoner under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, filed the delayed application even though he owes an outstanding balance to this Court in *John Robert Rawls v Dept of Corrections*, Docket Number 285201, a prior case he filed in this Court while a prisoner of the Department. A prisoner who is under the Department's jurisdiction cannot file another civil appeal or original action until the prisoner pays the outstanding balance owed in an earlier civil appeal or original action filed while under the Department's jurisdiction. MCL 600.2963(8).

The motion to waive fees is also DISMISSED as moot.
