The Court orders that the motion to supplement previously filed pleadings and the motion for immediate consideration of the motion to supplement are GRANTED.

The motion to remand pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(1) is DENIED because defendant-appellant has failed to demonstrate that the issue should be decided initially by the trial court or that development of a factual record is necessary for consideration of the issue. An evidentiary hearing is not necessary where the proposed testimony would not make a different result probable on retrial. *People v Mitchell*, 493 Mich 883; 822 NW2d 224 (2012).

The Court orders that the application for delayed leave to appeal is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented.
