Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the postjudgment order dated May 12, 2015 and entered in the circuit court register of actions on May 13, 2015 is not appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). Particularly, it is not a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) because it does not dispose of the claims by determining liability or damages but rather merely makes postjudgment determinations regarding enforcement of the earlier final order. The cases cited by appellant in support of its position that the order appealed from is a final order under MCR 7.202(6)(a)(i) are inapposite because they involve differing circumstances or are no longer relevant to this Court's jurisdiction over an appeal of right since they were decided before the adoption of the Michigan Court Rules with its definition in MCR 7.202(6)(a) of the types of orders and judgments in civil cases that are appealable of right.

The motions for immediate consideration and for stay are DENIED as moot.
