The Court orders that the motion to add issue is GRANTED so that the issues presented in that motion and supporting brief are considered as part of the delayed application for leave to appeal.

The delayed application for leave to appeal is GRANTED IN PART, limited to Issue I in the delayed application regarding defendant's claim that the fine imposed on him is invalid as being outside the plea agreement. In all other respects, the application for leave to appeal is DENIED for lack of merit in the grounds presented. The time for taking further steps in this appeal runs from the date of this order. MCR 7.205(E)(3).

The motion to remand and the motion to remand added issue are DENIED.

Judge O'Connell would grant leave to appeal as to all issues presented in the delayed application and the motion to add issue. He concurs with the grant of the motion to add issue and the denial of the motion to remand and motion to remand added issue.
