Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The delayed application for leave to appeal the Wayne Circuit Court's March 18, 2015 order is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. Defendant has not asserted a retroactive change in law or presented newly discovered evidence supporting his successive motion for relief from judgment as required by MCR 6.502(G)(2), and he may not appeal the denial of a successive motion for relief from judgment, MCR 6.502(G)(1).

The motion to remand for an evidentiary hearing/hearing pursuant to *People v Ginther*, 390 Mich 436; 212 NW2d 922 (1973), is DENIED as most since this Court lacks jurisdiction to consider the underlying delayed application for leave to appeal.

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED and fees are WAIVED for this case only.
