The Court orders that the motion to amend the delayed application for leave to appeal is GRANTED.

Because the time has expired for defendant to seek appeal of his conviction by leave, he may only seek relief under the procedures provided by Subchapter 6.500 of the Michigan Court Rules in the lower court below. Accordingly, defendant's delayed application seeking leave from the lower court's denial of his "motion to remand" was examined under the standards set forth under MCR 6.508(D).

The delayed application is DENIED because defendant has failed to meet the burden of establishing entitlement to relief under MCR 6.508(D). The defendant alleges grounds for relief that could have been raised previously and he has failed to establish good cause for failing to previously raise the issues, and has not established that good cause should be waived. MCR 6.508(D)(3)(a).

The motion to waive fees is GRANTED and fees are WAIVED for this case only.
