

Chief Judge Michael J. Talbot, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and MCR 7.211(E)(2),  
orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the orders of the circuit court on appeal from an administrative tribunal are not appealable as a matter of right. MCR 7.203(A)(1)(a). An appeal from an order of the circuit court on appeal from another tribunal must come by application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205. MCR 7.203(B)(2). Accordingly, at this time, appellant may seek to appeal the November 6, 2015, orders only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
