Click the hyperlink in the email message to play the audio file. The audio file is in MP3 format. The recording will play in your default media player. (If necessary, you can download this software for free

from the Internet. Windows Media Player and Real Player are popular media players.) The file size will vary, depending on the length of the recording.

We suggest that you save the audio file to your computer to ensure that you have access to the file in the future. The method you use to save the file will depend on your email service and media player. In general, you should be able to use one of the following techniques.

- Once you click the hyperlink to listen to the recording, the file has downloaded to a temporary location on your computer. To permanently save the file, **choose File, Save As from the media player menu** and select a permanent location for the audio file.
- Right-click the MP3 link in the email message and select Save Target As. (This is an option in some email services.) In the Save As dialog box, select where you would like to save the file and click the Save button. After the download is complete, click the MP3 file and your default media player will open and play the file.

Use the media player controls to adjust the volume and control the playback of the recorded audio.
