The Court orders that the motion to remand pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(1) is DENIED for failure to persuade the Court of the necessity of a remand at this time. Under *People v Lockridge*, 498 Mich 358; 870 NW2d 502 (2015), remand is mandatory if the guidelines minimum sentence range changes when recalculated without consideration of facts not found by the jury or admitted by the defendant and this recalculation of the sentencing guidelines may be done on the current record.
