The Court orders that the parties file supplemental briefs on the matters that the Supreme Court has directed this Court to consider on remand, including: (1) whether the district court correctly concluded that Roberts lacked the authority to conduct a stop of defendant; (2) whether defendant knew or had reason to know that Roberts was performing his duties at the time of defendant's conduct; and (3) whether Roberts' command to stop was lawful.
