Pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), in lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, the Court REMANDS this matter to the Washtenaw Circuit Court for further proceedings consistent with the process set forth in *People v Lockridge*, 498 Mich 358; 870 NW2d 502 (2015), *United States v Crosby*, 397 F3d 103 (CA 2, 2005), and *People v Steanhouse*, ___ Mich App ___; __ NW2d ___ (2015). On remand, the circuit court also shall establish a factual basis for the \$1,611 in costs imposed or alter that figure, if appropriate. *People v Konopka*, 309 Mich App 345; 869 NW2d 651 (2015). To avoid future remands, we strongly suggest that the trial court adopt a practice of placing on the record at sentencing an explanation of why the costs imposed were reasonably related to actual costs. This order has immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F). The Court does not retain jurisdiction.
