Amy Ronayne Krause, Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion for leave to file cross appeal is DENIED. The motion appears carefully written to avoid stating the date that appellee Lane Sherman's (appellee) counsel actually received a copy of the claim of appeal. If appellee wished to pursue a claim of cross appeal he should have filed a claim of cross appeal at the latest within 21 days after that date rather than filing a motion to be allowed to file a late claim of cross appeal. See MCR 7.207(B)(1). Further, correspondence from appellee's counsel to this Court makes clear that he was aware of this appeal by February 3, 2016, but the present motion was not filed until far more than 21 days after that date. Notably, appellee may file a delayed application for leave to appeal as to the November 16, 2015 judgment within the six-month time limit provided by MCR 7.205(G)(3).
