Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because it was not filed within 21 days of the order being appealed from, which is dated December 2, 2015 and was entered in the circuit court register of actions on December 4, 2015, and no motion for postjudgment relief was filed within the initial 21-day appeal period. MCR 7.204(A)(1)(a). In this regard, the claim of appeal filed on January 4, 2016 was not timely filed even recognizing that the 21-day period was extended to December 29, 2015 by the Christmas holiday and the early closure of this Court on December 28, 2015. MCR 1.108(1). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the December 4, 2015 order only by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
