The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

Pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), in lieu of granting the application for leave to appeal, the Court orders that this matter is REMANDED to the Kent Circuit Court for the limited purpose of allowing the trial court to supplement the record regarding the acceptance of the nolo contendere plea by stating on the record why the plea of nolo contendere is appropriate in this case. *People v Holcomb*, 400 Mich 840, 841 (1977). In all other regards, the application for leave to appeal is DENIED for failure to persuade the Court of the need for immediate appellate review. This order has immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F)(2). The Court does not retain jurisdiction.
