Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1), orders:

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the February 8, 2016 order denying appellant's motion for reconsideration of the judgment of divorce dated December 18, 2015, and entered in the circuit court register of actions on January 4, 2016, is not a final order appealable of right. MCR 7.202(6)(a); MCR 7.203(A). Further, the claim of appeal cannot be saved by treating it as being taken from the judgment of divorce because the relevant motion for reconsideration, being filed on January 26, 2016, was not filed within 21 days after entry of the judgment and the trial court did not allow further time for filing such a motion during that 21-day period. MCR 7.204(A)(1)(b). At this time, appellant may seek to appeal the judgment of divorce by filing a delayed application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(G).
