The Court orders pursuant to MCR 7.206(D)(4) and MCR 7.216(A)(7), that the matter is REMANDED to the trial court for resolution of plaintiff's "Motion to Expand or Settle the Record." MCR 6.433(C)(2) expressly requires the clerk to provide an indigent criminal defendant with additional copies of the record and transcripts for postconviction proceedings "on defendant's showing of good cause to the court." Additionally, MCR 6.433(C)(3) permits a trial court to order transcripts of additional proceedings "if it finds there is good cause for doing so." Accordingly, on remand, the trial court must determine if plaintiff supported his motion with the requisite good cause to obtain relief.
