The Court orders that the motion to waive fees is GRANTED and fees are WAIVED for this case only.

The Court further orders that the motion for leave to file a brief in excess of 50 pages is GRANTED and the brief filed on April 15, 2016 is accepted for filing.

The Court orders that the delayed application for leave to appeal is GRANTED, limited to the issue raised in Issue II of the application. MCR 7.205(E)(4). The time for taking further steps in this appeal runs from the date of the Clerk's certification of this order. MCR 7.205(E)(3). Because the prosecutor failed to file an answer to the delayed application for leave to appeal, the Court orders that the prosecutor must file an appellee's brief in reply to appellant's brief, either within 56 days of the Clerk's certification of this order as directed in MCR 6.509(D), or within the time stated in MCR 7.212(A)(2)(a), whichever is later.

In all other regards, the delayed application for leave to appeal is DENIED because defendant has failed to establish that the trial court erred in denying the motion for relief from judgment.

Murphy, J., would deny the delayed application for leave.
