Pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), the Court orders that the decision of the 19th District Court, dismissing the charges of possession with intent to deliver Xanax and Vicodin and possession of a firearm during the commission of a felony, and the Wayne County Circuit Court's March 31, 2016 order affirming that decision are REVERSED. The prosecution presented sufficient evidence to support probable cause to find that the offenses were committed and that defendant committed them. *People v Redden*, 290 Mich App 65, 83-84; 799 NW2d 184 (2010). It presented evidence supporting the charges; to the extent that the evidence raises a reasonable doubt regarding defendant's guilt, those questions are to be resolved by the trier of fact. *Id.* at 84. The district court abused its discretion in failing to bind defendant over on the charges. *People v Waterstone*, 296 Mich App 121, 131-132; 818 NW2d 432 (2012).

This matter is REMANDED to the 19th District Court with instructions to bind defendant over on the charges.

This order is to have immediate effect. MCR 7.215(F)(2).

This Court retains no further jurisdiction.
