The Court orders that the motion to extend the time to file the transcript is GRANTED ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT the transcripts are due from Court Reporter Sherry Scott (R 4640) on September 27, 2016.

The transcripts were ordered on May 17, 2016. On August 24, 2016, Reporter Scott filed a motion seeking an additional 63 days in which to complete the transcripts, which were due on August 16, 2016. One hundred and fifty-four days to produce these overdue transcripts is not a reasonable amount of time.

If a copy of the notice of filing the transcript has not been filed with the Clerk's Office of the Court of Appeals on or before September 27, 2016, the court reporter may be subject to disciplinary action pursuant to MCR 7.210(B)(3)(f), which could include the assessment of costs, issuance of an order barring the court reporter from recording further proceedings until all of the reporter's overdue transcripts ordered for purposes of appeal are filed with the trial court clerk, and/or issuance of an order to show cause why the reporter is not in contempt of this Court.

The reporter is directed to immediately confer with Third Judicial Circuit Court Director of Court Reporting Services Tammi Palmer and Third Judicial Circuit Court Criminal Division Supervisor of Court Reporting/Recording Services Richard Josephs regarding her current workload. If the reporter will not be able to complete the transcripts by September 27, 2016, the reporter should be given appropriate assistance so that the transcripts may be filed by September 27, 2016.
