In lieu of granting the delayed application for leave to appeal, pursuant to MCR 7.205(E)(2), the Court orders the case REMANDED to the trial court for a hearing to conduct the restitution hearing required by the judgment of sentence. MCL 780.767; *People v Harper*, 496 Mich 855; 847 NW2d 497 (2014). On remand the trial court shall articulate a reason for the court costs assessed in the judgment of sentence. *People v Konopka*, 309 Mich App 345, 360; 869 NW2d 651 (2015). If the trial court has started collecting the costs of court-appointed counsel from defendant, then the court must also evaluate defendant's ability to pay those costs. *People v Jackson*, 483 Mich 271, 292; 769 NW2d 630 (2009).

This Court retains no further jurisdiction.
