Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E)(2), orders:

The motion to extend time to file appellant's brief is GRANTED until January 20, 2017.

The Court observes that counsel has requested multiple extensions throughout 2016, including in the following appeals: Docket Nos. 330036, 331590, 332113 (two extensions), 332633, 333639, 335035, as well as in the instant matter. Counsel is reminded that cases involving termination of parental rights require expedited processing from the initial filing, the production of the transcript, the filing of the brief, through the placement on the case call. See MCR 7.204(A)(1)(c), MCR 7.210(B)(3)(b)(iii), MCR 7.212(A)(1)(a)(i), and MCR 7.213(C)(2). Further, IOP 7.212(A)(1)-3 indicates that motions for extensions of time in cases where the appellant's brief is due in less than 56 days will be granted only for good cause shown, including unexpected events that directly impact the ability to timely file the brief. Counsel is advised that future extensions in appeals involving termination of parental rights cases are discouraged and are unlikely to be granted absent a showing of such an unexpected event.
