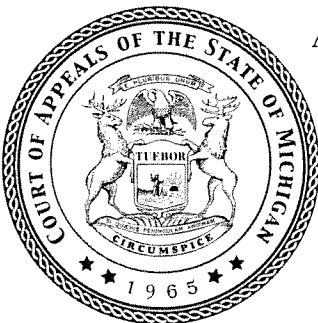

Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.203(F)(1) and MCR 7.211(E)(2),
orders:

The “affidavit of indigency and financial schedule” that was filed by appellant is treated as a motion to waive fees and is GRANTED for this case only.

The claim of appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the judgment of sentence, which was signed on October 5, 1998 and entered by the trial court on the register of actions on October 7, 1998, was based upon a plea of guilty or no contest to a crime committed after December 27, 1994. Therefore, it is not appealable as a matter of right. MCR 7.203(A)(1)(b).
