The motions for immediate consideration are GRANTED.

The motion to file a reply to the answer is also GRANTED.

The motion to stay appeal pending worker's compensation proceedings is recognized as a motion to hold this appeal in abeyance. The motion is GRANTED TO THE EXTENT that this appeal is HELD IN ABEYANCE until the worker's compensation magistrate in the relevant worker's compensation proceedings issues a decision as to whether the incident underlying this case is subject to the Workers' Disability Compensation Act. This order is without prejudice to any party filing a further motion for abeyance or to extend time for filing a brief after the worker's compensation magistrate's decision is issued.
