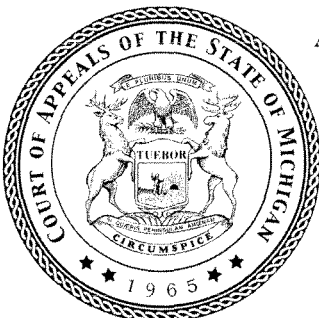

Michael J. Talbot, Chief Judge, acting under MCR 7.211(E), orders:

On the Court's own motion, the original complaint for mandamus is DISMISSED because plaintiff, a prisoner under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, filed the subject original complaint for mandamus even though he owes an outstanding balance in *Leon Duane Bridinger v Parnall Road Correctional Facility Warden*, Docket Number 319902. A prisoner who is under the Department's jurisdiction cannot file another civil appeal or original action until the prisoner pays the outstanding balance owed in an earlier civil appeal or original action filed while under the Department's jurisdiction. MCL 600.2963(8).

The motions to waive fees and for immediate consideration are DENIED as moot.
